Dear Parents and Carers,



From 1st June, St. Peter's will be opening further for the children of key workers, vulnerable children and the children in Year 1

This will be a big increase in the number of children currently attending school. In order to keep children, staff and parents safe, the following routines **must** be followed by everyone entering the school site for drop off and pick up:

- Entrance to school must be by the double gates opposite Stanley Library/Community Centre
- Exit from school must be by the wide side gate adjacent to the school car park
- The entrance and exit gates will be clearly signed
- The gates at the front of school will be locked
- Children must be accompanied by **one adult only** and dropped off at their 'bubble' group.
- Children will stand on an 'X' painted on the ground
- The teacher for each 'bubble' group will be waiting to collect the children and take them into school
- **Parents/carers must not approach teachers** – all communication must be via phone, email or the website contact page
- Drop off and pick up times are staggered and must be strictly adhered to (a text will be sent on Thursday 28th May with the drop off and pick up time; and the name of the child's teacher)
- Parents/carers must drop off and pick up quickly and keep moving in the direction of the exit
- Parents/carers must not congregate on the school play ground
- No one will be admitted into school via the main entrance
- All children must wear school uniform, bring their own water bottle and a packed lunch (if they are not having a school packed lunch). The packed lunch must be in a disposable bag or container – no lunch boxes
- On 1st June children must bring back to school their Power Maths and Reading books
- No other items can be brought in from home

Face coverings:

- The government have advised the wearing of face coverings, for example a scarf, in busy public spaces
- Mr Fish and Miss Wiggins will be wearing face coverings and will be on the playground/front of school to direct children and adults
- Staff and children will not be wearing face coverings
- Face coverings will not be worn in the school

Drop off and pick up times:

- We have done our best to keep sibling drop off and pick up times the same. This has not been possible in every case. If your children have different Drop off and Pick up times you must leave the school by the exit and return at the stated time via the entrance

Safety protocols:

- Previous letters have detailed some of the safety protocols in place.
- A complete set of safety protocols and the school's risk assessment is now on the school website in the 'Policies and Parent Protocols' section.

Please note that whilst we intend to proceed with the wider opening of St. Peter's from 1st June, this is subject to any further announcements from the Government on Thursday 28th May.
