

PROPOSED INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is Stanley St Peter's CE (VC) Primary School.
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is the Governing Body of Stanley St Peter's CE (VC) Primary School.
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a) 2 Parent Governors;
 - b) 1 LA Governor;
 - c) 1 Staff Governor;
 - d) The Headteacher;
 - e) 2 Foundation Governors;
 - f) 4 Co-opted Governor.
5. Total number of governors is 11.
6. The Leeds Diocesan Board of Education, after consultation with Stanley Parochial Church Council, shall be the foundation body entitled to appoint **two** Foundation Governors.
7. (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:
Principal Officiating Minister of Stanley.

(b) The foundation body or person named in paragraph 8 shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated is entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. The school has a Trust Deed.
10. The ethos of the school is that, recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

13. This instrument of government comes into effect on 13 January 2021
14. This instrument was made by order of the City of Wakefield Metropolitan District Local Authority on 29 January 2021
15. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
