celebrations to a whole new level. It was delightful to see such a vibrant array of characters roaming our school corridors!

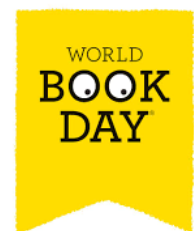

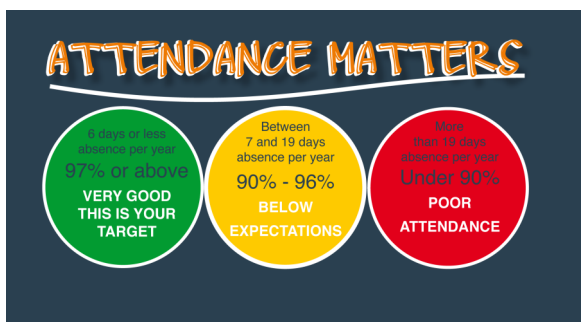
