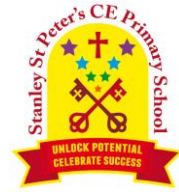

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reach the end of the first half-term, I am reminded of just how quickly the time has flown by! Your children have worked exceptionally hard over the past eight weeks, and I am sure they are ready for a well-deserved break.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that individual school photos will be taken on Thursday, 7th November. Please ensure your child comes to school looking smart and wearing the correct uniform on this day.

It is also a pleasure to congratulate all of our Friendship Value Award winners from each class. The children are allowed to wear the wristbands they received in school, but I kindly ask that no other jewellery be worn.

Looking ahead, I want to inform you that significant work will commence after the half-term to replace the library floor. A new ventilation solution will also be installed in this room, which will affect our KSI playground for approximately eight weeks. Most classes will still line up in the playground in their usual spots at the beginning and end of the day. However, Y5 Elton Class (Miss Sales' class) will need to line up in the ginnel next to the small hall (opposite the dining hall).
