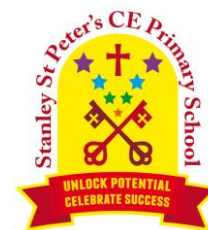

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING PARENT'S ATTENDANCE AT
NATIVITY PRODUCTIONS**

Dear Parents/Carers

You will be acutely aware that many schools are no longer allowing parents to attend their school Christmas productions in person due to rises in COVID cases in the area and the threat posed from the new Omicron variant.

We have decided to still allow parents to attend these at our school but it would be ill-advised for us to go ahead without putting some additional safety measures in place.

Therefore, if you would like to attend your child's Christmas show you MUST:

- Provide proof of a negative lateral flow test result on the day of your attendance (when you have taken your lateral flow test, you should report your result on this link <https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result> , you will then get an email or text message to state that your result was negative – this is what you will need to show to gain entry to school). Please note that if you do not have this proof you WILL NOT PERMITTED TO ENTER SCHOOL.
- Wear a mask (if you cannot wear a mask due to being medically exempt you must show proof that you are exempt).
- Only **one** parent/carer per family will be allowed to attend each show (we have put additional shows on so that every family gets the opportunity for two adults to attend but at different shows – please see the separate letter which details the dates and times of the productions).
- Arrive at least half an hour before the start of the show in order for our staff to conduct the necessary checks.

The above conditions **do not apply** to our Year 5 & 6 Christmas Carol Concert as this will take place outside on the KS2 playground.

Please DO NOT attend any shows if you have symptoms of Coronavirus.

If you require any lateral flow tests, please contact school or call into the office to collect some.

We would really like to avoid any upset on the day of the shows so please ensure that you fully understand the requirements of entry and if you are unsure about anything, please contact us on 01924 663641.

I will continue to monitor the situation and if circumstances change drastically I will not hesitate to take further action which may include switching to delivering the Christmas shows virtually via our YouTube channel instead.

Let's all work together to keep everyone safe and give everyone the chance to enjoy Christmas!
