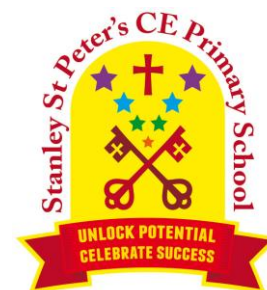


Tuesday 16th December 2025
