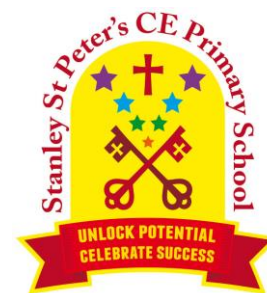

We recommend ensuring that your child reads for at least 20 minutes per day. The importance of reading for children cannot be underestimated. Reading for pleasure can benefit a child's education, social and cognitive development, their wellbeing, and their mental health. **Don't forget to sign your child's reading record** so that they can earn points and win prizes too as part of our Read to Succeed initiative and our staff are always looking to add new photographs to their Extreme Reading displays so please don't forget to email your child's class teacher if your child performs a wacky way of reading!
