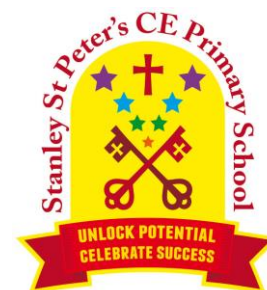

Y4 Multiplication Check

Our Y4 children will be completing the optional DfE Y4 Multiplication Check between 7th June to 18th June. This will become a compulsory check (just as the phonics screening check in Y1 is compulsory) from 2022. The aim of the check is to ensure that all children leave primary school with good recall of their timestables up to 12 and therefore, it will provide us with information about whether any of our Y4 children require further support in order to achieve this.
