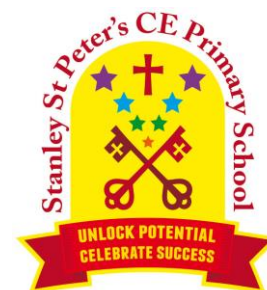

### Risk Assessment

I have reviewed our risk assessment which has more or less reverted back to how it was before Christmas. (We were overcautious before so a lot of the recommendations in the latest government guidance were things that we were already doing.) I have sent this out to staff for consultation and then need to send it to governors and once it is finalised I will put it on our website and write to you again.

## Uniform Expectations

Uniform expectations remain the same as ever. Wearing a uniform really helps to provide the children with a sense of unity, belonging and the need to conform. The children will require structure and routine upon their return and we feel that our uniform (amongst many other things) helps us to provide that.

On my last letter I gave details about a uniform charity that helps parents out who are struggling financially – please do contact them to see if they can help if you need to. If you still have any difficulties adhering to the uniform expectations, please get in touch with the school office.

## Devices Loaned

If you loaned an iPad, Chromebook or Laptop from school during lockdown, please ensure that you return these on **Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> March** (the first day back at school) as these devices will be required for use by the children during the school day. As a school we invested over £13,000 of our capital budget to purchase new devices (we did receive a small number of devices from the DfE too) and so I hope you can appreciate that we need to protect that investment and ensure that they are all returned.

For those children that will be joining us for the first time in nursery on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March, one of our members of staff should have been in touch with you individually to relay the arrangements for induction of your child to our school.
